WELCOME TO WAVENEY HOUSE HOTEL - THE HOTEL BY THE RIVER

Situated in the picturesque Waveney Valley, the Waveney House Hotel boasts a superb river location with stunning views across the surrounding countryside.

Its peaceful setting is perfect for relaxing yet is also close to the town centre of Beccles with its shops, cafes and historic places of interest, making it an ideal base for river activities or discovering the delights of the area.

Steeped in history, the hotel was built in the early 16th Century during the reign of King Henry VIII. The first owner William Rede I, was the first Lord of the Manor of Beccles, after the Dissolution of the Monasteries. The current building retains a lot of the original features of that period, including the vaulted oak-beamed ceilings to the second floor accommodation. This is combined with thoughtful and tasteful décor to create a charming atmosphere.



Parking is provided for those arriving by car and moorings can be booked in advance for those arriving by river.



LUXURY ACCOMMODATION



The hotel offers 12 luxury bedrooms, all with en-suite bathrooms and each individually styled. Both the Crowfoot Suite and the Le Grys Suite boast not only a four-poster bed, but also exceptional views across the river and Gillingham Marshes.

Other rooms either share the river view or alternatively have a view of the Church of St Michael, famed for its tower being completely separate from the main body of the church.





THE STAITHE RESTAURANT
AND RIVERSIDE BAR



Enjoy our superb restaurant cuisine in a quiet and relaxed atmosphere overlooking the river. Our chef is only too happy to discuss with you any special dietary needs you may have.

Unwind with a drink – our conservatory allows you to enjoy the views to the river and countryside in the colder months whilst remaining warm and dry. In warmer weather take advantage of the river terrace and watch the boats go by.

FUNCTION FACILITIES

The Waveney Suite boasts its own bar and lounge area, a spacious dance floor and a stage. It forms the perfect venue for conferences,

meetings, weddings, birthday parties, shows, keep fit classes, discos, wakes, christenings and any special occasion you may have. The main function room can seat up to 130 people (depending on layout)

and approximately 200 people standing or dancing. There is a large stage, complete with PA system. Also available are a keyboard, disco lighting and a hardwood floor suitable for dancing.



The Waveney Suite Bar and Lounge adjoining the Main Suite can be hired separately and are ideal for smaller functions, comfortably seating up to 25 people. The layout for each room can be arranged to suit your own requirements. Hire of the rooms are available from quarter day to a full day. A range of menus and themed refreshment breaks can be provided.

We can cater for a full sit down menu service, or buffets, to tea and biscuits.

The garden gazebo in the grounds is ideal for photoshoots and beautiful views of the river create backdrops for your photographs.

Ample car parking is available in the grounds with additional public parking in Puddingmoor.

CONFERENCES

Standard equipment is included in your conference suite hire charge – we can supply an overhead projector, television, video, flipchart, and screen. In addition we can provide stationery and various refreshments as required on the table for delegates.


Should you require an LCD projector, extra flipchart or 12ft x 12ft screen, they are available at a further charge, and must be booked in advance.

A luxurious four poster with views overlooking the River Waveney makes this the perfect end to a perfect day, friends and family are also invited to stay.



...AND DURING YOUR STAY


